# In the Graduate Certificate and Graduate Diploma of Addictive Behaviours you will:

- Learn about theory and concepts to understand how addiction problems can develop and persist.
- Explore how addiction impacts individuals, families, communities and social systems.
- Develop skills to identify and assess for addiction issues and understand appropriate treatment interventions.
- Develop relevant skills for critiquing the evidence base and understanding its contribution to shaping policy and therapeutic responses.

## **GRADUATE CERTIFICATE**

Foundation studies in addictive behaviours

Develop foundational knowledge of theories and models of addiction, policy and public health responses to substance use disorders and other addictions. Learn about the tools and interventions used in the professional practice of working in the alcohol and other drug sector.

## **GRADUATE DIPLOMA**

Core studies in addictive behaviours

Deepen your knowledge of how addiction narratives are understood through social and cultural perspectives. Evaluate policies and how prevention measures have been applied in a range of settings to reduce addiction-related harm. Learn about different ways of responding to addiction.
