

CHCAOD001 Work in an alcohol and other drugs context (6 July 2026 – 28 August 2026)

Turning Point (RTO 6948) provides Vocational Education and Training (VET) opportunities to the Victorian Alcohol and Other Drugs (AOD) workforce.

This training is targeted at employees currently in the AOD sector and employed in Victorian DH funded AOD Services. Turning Point staff delivering the AOD competencies have both AOD experience and meet the training and assessment requirements as outlined in the Australian Quality Training Framework (AQTF).

Expression of Interest (EOI) only

Applicants must be currently employed in Victorian DH funded services in an AOD role to be eligible to apply for this training. This is an expression of interest only and you must be available to attend all mandatory virtual classes advertised.

Selection Criteria: To enrol in a unit of competency you must work in a publicly funded organisation in the Victorian AOD sector and be an Australian Citizen/Permanent Resident or New Zealand Citizen.

There is no cost to complete units of competency if you meet the selection criteria.

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to establish and work within the current context, philosophy and values of the AOD sector. This unit applies to workers who work directly with clients affected by alcohol and other drugs.

Blended delivery: Online and virtual classes

Training and assessment components are delivered in an online learning environment.

Student resources essential for your learning will be available via the online Learning Management System. (Moodle)

This unit of competency is assessed, and you will be required to complete assessment tasks.

Live Simulation:
